To stand near the spectacular red cliffs above the mighty Columbia River and sip a glass of wine is a joyous adventure, and Cave B offers it all. Relax in one of the well-appointed rooms overlooking the river, with wall-to-wall glass windows, fireplaces and all the privacy you could ask for. Or linger outside in the summer and you might hear a song from the likes of Dave Matthews playing a concert at the Gorge Amphitheater just steps away. The wine, such as the tasty 2003 Cuvée du Soleil, complements a variety of foods; chef Fernando Divina of Tendrils Restaurant pairs it with innovative regional fare, including local quail, Walla Walla onions and Monteillet farmstead cheeses, often using produce straight from the on-site organic chef's garden.
